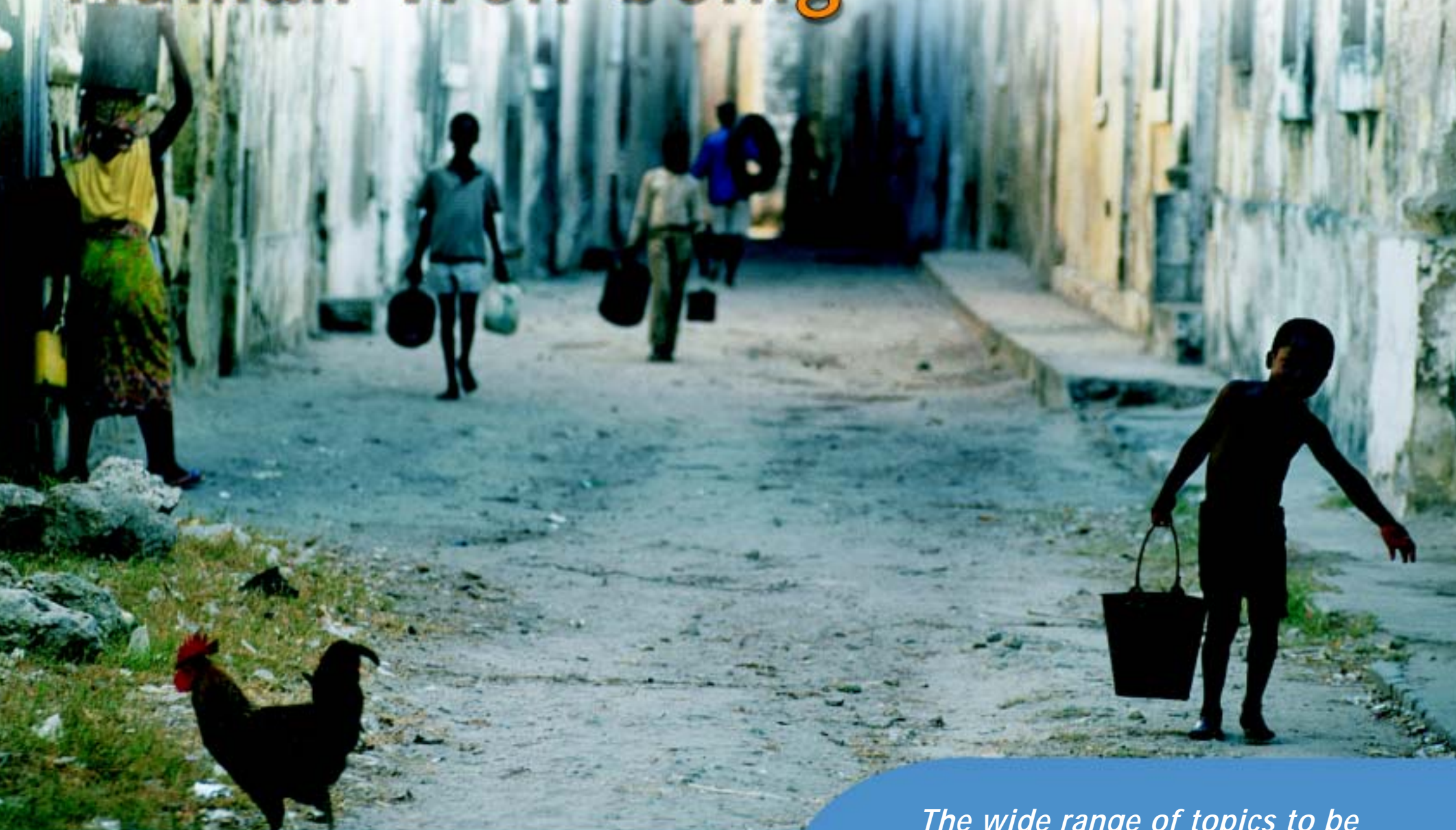


WIDER CONFERENCE ON
